MARYDEL, Delaware - January 20, 2012 – The Brandywine Hundred Fire Company in New Castle County, Delaware has selected Rosenbauer to rechassis and refurbish one of their apparatus. Rescue 11, a 1997 Salisbury stainless steel rescue pumper on a Simon-Duplex chassis will be refurbished by Rosenbauer's Minnesota Division. The following paragraphs are an abbreviated description of the scope of work to be performed throughout the project.

The chassis for the new Rescue 11 will be a 2012 Spartan Gladiator LFD with a 10" raised roof. Features include a Cummins ISL9 450 HP motor, Alcoa Dura-Bright aluminum wheels, Meritor EX225 17" front disc brakes, (3) FRC Spectra 12V LED scene lights – (1) brow and (1) on each side of cab, severe-duty interior trim package, and seating for (7) personnel.

Upon arrival at the Rosenbauer factory by flat bed truck, the body will be completely stripped of all equipment and lights, and thoroughly inspected with any damaged areas receiving necessary repairs. The entire exterior surface of the body will be sanded, prepped, and repainted. All hinged doors will be removed and replaced with ROM roll-up doors. Existing warning lights will be replaced with Whelen LED lights and all scene lights will be replaced with Havis Magnafire 3000 750W quartz lights. Other new features to be installed include LED strip lights in all compartments, an oil dry hopper w/discharge hose, (3) portable winch receivers w/12-volt outlet, a Will-Burt Nightscan light tower.

The entire body will be completely rewired, new LED DOT lighting installed, and SCBA storage compartments will be installed in the rear wheelwell areas. A wide array of shelves, trays, and tool boards will be fabricated and installed throughout the body. The 28" extended front bumper will be configured to house a hydraulic reel, pre-connected hydraulic rescue tool, and 150' of 1-3/4" hose supplied by a bumper discharge. All of these components will be protected under a full-width aluminum treadplate door. The pump module, pump, plumbing, and valves will all be removed and inspected. Foam educators will be installed on selected discharges. These lines will be supplied by a 30 gallon foam tank equipped with a Hypo foam refill system. A 20kW Harrison hydraulic generator will be installed in the dunnage area and both pump panels will be enclosed with ROM roll-up doors.
